


PEI POTATO OBSTACLE COURSE

Watch your potato grow to new lengths with this potato obstacle course!

MATERIALS

- 1 cardboard box with a lid (a shoebox works well)
- Extra cardboard
- Scissors
- Tape
- 1 Sprouted potato



STEPS

1.Cut out strips of cardboard the same depth as your box. These will be used for the maze. You can make the maze as easy or challenging as you like, but it will take longer for your potato to get through the more passes it has to make.

2. Cut a hole out of one end of your box for light to get through, about 3" by 3". This will be the end of your maze.

3. Tape the pieces of cardboard inside the box any way you'd like to create the obstacle course.

4. Place the sprouted potato at the beginning of the maze (opposite end of the hole).

5. Place the lid over the box and seal any light leaks with tape. Place in a sunny area, Make sure the hole in your cardboard box is directly facing the sunniest point.

6. Check up on your sprouting potato every few days to see how it's doing!
